

- 3. The participating teams need to prepare and bring the hard copy of Poster as per the registered project in Vigyan Utsav- 2023. Kindly refer to the attached format for the poster for your reference please (Height = 3 Feet, Width = 2 Feet, Portrait Orientation). Please adhere to the headings mentioned in the Poster format.
- 4. Each project is assigned with unique Project ID at the time of receiving the entry. The Project ID will be shared through mail on the registered mail ID.
- 5. Please bring your own charged Laptop(s) / Power Cable(s) / Connecting Wire(s) / Any other Hardware / Software(s) required for the display of your project. All participants must ensure to share their requirements in details such as no. electric points etc.
- 6. In case the project display requires an outdoor space / ground floor space due to its large size and capacity then the participant needs to inform the undersigned with detailed requirements latest by 26 th October 2023.
- 7. Participating schools will be responsible for arranging transportation for their students to and from the event location.

- Problem Statement: Clearly define the real-world problem you're addressing.
- Solution Description: Explain your innovative idea and how it tackles the problem.

- Expected Impact: Share the potential impact and benefits of your idea.
- Q&A: Be prepared to answer questions from the judges and the audience.

4. Judges and Prizes

Debate

A debate is a discussion or structured contest about an issue or a resolution. A formal debate involves two sides: one supporting a resolution and one opposing it. Such a debate is bound by rules previously agreed upon. Debates may be judged in order to declare a winning side. Debates, in one form or another, are commonly used in democratic societies to explore and resolve issues and problems. Decisions at a board meeting, public hearing, legislative assembly, or local organization are often reached through discussion and debate. Indeed, any discussion of a resolution is a form of debate, which may or may not follow formal rules (such as Robert's Rules of Order). In the context of a classroom, the topic for debate will be guided by the knowledge, skill, and value outcomes in the curriculum.


Important rules

- · Time Duration for each participant: 3 min and 1 minute for answering questions (if any)
- · The team supporting the motion must not shift its point of view. The same goes for the opposition, who must oppose the motion completely (whatever their private opinions may be).
- · If a speaker makes a statement, they must be able to provide evidence or reasons to support the statement.
- · Facts presented in a debate must be accurate.
- · Speakers may not bring up new points in a rebuttal speech.

Judging

The winning team in a debate is usually decided on the basis of the quality of the debating, by a judge, or judges.
