Background of the workshop:

This one-day workshop is designed for the leaders and senior faculty members of higher education institutions. Other members of the senior management, heads of schools, deans, directors of various functions, academic and assessment board members and curriculum planners can also benefit from attending this workshop.

The workshop is designed to spur new thinking about institutional readiness for the digital economy. The participants will be able to learn about global trends and see the role of their institution in a wider context.

It will address the following key areas:

- The role of the curriculum and how changing ideas about knowledge and expertise shape what the curriculum of the future looks like
- The delivery of education and how insights from cognitive science should be used to transform classroom practice.
